Access Services is excited to announce the merger of our Adult and Children's Crisis Programs in Montgomery County. This merger culminates months of planning and preparation toward the development of one crisis program for all people in Montgomery County, in an effort to bring more resource and crisis responsiveness to all ages and systems. Competent and caring crisis workers will help you resolve crisis situations like depression or suicidal thoughts through telephone and mobile support when needed. Montgomery County Mobile Crisis is here to help with immediate crisis situations and help reduce and manage recurring crisis. All services are provided at no charge.



The Mobile Crisis Program recognizes the importance of partnership and of shared responsibility toward safer communities. We are thrilled to continue to partner with law enforcement and other emergency responders, with hospital systems and other providers, with community organizations and faith communities, and with schools in support of persons and families. Mobile Crisis seeks to ensure that immediate support is made available across the County, thereby reducing the need for higher

levels of care when possible, and facilitating higher levels of care as needed.



Access Services prides itself in program innovation and the ability to work efficiently as a leading nonprofit agency in Montgomery County. Having these two programs under the same roof, working together to assist our community has already shown its benefits. In the month of December, Mobile Crisis was able to assist 33% more adolescent clients! With the goal being to stabilize families and prevent hospitalization, you can see just how impactful that increase in interventions can be for our community.

In addition to supporting individuals and families, Mobile Crisis aims to support our community partners in themselves becoming even better crisis managers. Mobile Crisis is always available for consultation and for training in crisis intervention, suicide intervention and education, and in de-escalation.

Moving forward, both adult and adolescent crisis intervention will be handled by one incredible group of crisis workers located in Plymouth Meeting.
