



New Grant Opportunities for Local Nonprofits Coming Spring 2018 !!!

The VNA Foundation of Greater North Penn provides a Spring and a Fall grant cycle each year to support local nonprofit organizations with the capacity to strengthen lives and address significant needs present within the North Penn region of Montgomery County, thus building stronger and healthier communities in this region for generations to come.

Interested nonprofit organizations may go online to the VNA Foundation's website, at www.npvnafoundation.org for additional information after December 15, 2017 to read more about applying online for the Spring 2018 grant cycle, or call the VNA Foundation office to discuss potential projects any time at 215-847-4401. All applications must be submitted online (www.npvnafoundation.org), and the grant application process begins with a Letter of Intent (LOI), **available to be completed online between January 16, 2018 and February 16, 2018.**

The LOI will require specific goals to be defined under the grant request and should focus on addressing *positive outcomes projected in serving individuals and families residing within the North Penn region of Montgomery County*. Nonprofit organizations may request general operating support, program support, or capacity-building support, yet the request must connect directly to how this potential grant support would specifically benefit those residing within the North Penn region of Montgomery County.

All LOI requests will be reviewed after the February 16th deadline, and only those successful organizations approved to complete an entire application will move ahead in the grant process for this 2018 Spring grant cycle. Applicants invited to complete an entire application may complete this online between March 12 and April 9, 2018. Successful grantees will be notified in June 2018, and checks will be awarded to successful grantees prior to June 30, 2018. Grants will cover a twelve-month period, with additional requirements for a six-month progress report, a site visit, and a final report to be completed under the grant agreement.
